



CHAPTER 155

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Gérard Raymond to the study of the profession of advocate, without examination

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS Gérard Raymond, domiciled in the town of Lachute, district of Terrebonne, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is twenty-one years of age;

That he studied in the office of Mtre. J. A. Robillard, K.C., advocate, in the city of Montreal;

That he attended the classical course at Bourget College, up to the Arts Course, and afterwards had private instruction;

That he suffered a very serious illness which prevented him from continuing his classical studies, and his present state of health is such that he is not able, and will not be able to again enter a classical college to continue his classical studies;

That he very much desires to begin the study of the legal profession, but is unable to do so, through ill health, unless he be admitted by an act of the Legislature, without preliminary examination;

That he is prepared to meet all requirements of the Bar for admission to the study of the profession of advocate, save that of undergoing the preliminary examination, which his present state of health prevents;

That the Council of the Bar of Montreal, at its sitting of the 25th of April, 1927, passed a resolution, recommending that the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec approve the prayer of the petitioner and the present act;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, at a general meeting held in the city of Montreal

on the 4th of June, 1927, unanimously approved the passing of an act to allow the petitioner to be admitted to the study of law, without preliminary examination;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for an act for the above purposes, and it is expedient to grant the prayer to that effect contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar authorized to admit Gérard Raymond to the study of law.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Gérard Raymond to the study of the profession of advocate, without having to undergo the preliminary examination for that purpose, and the secretary-treasurer of the General Council of the Bar is authorized to grant him a certificate as student.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
