



CHAPTER 157

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Henry Leo Silverstone amongst its members, after examination

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS Henry Leo Silverstone, of the city of Mont-^{Preamble.}
real, law student, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is a British subject of the full age of majority and holds a degree of Bachelor of Arts conferred on him by McGill University;

That he was admitted to the study of law in the Province of Quebec in July, 1924, and was articled under deed of indenture;

That subsequently he studied law in England and was called to the Bar by the Middle Temple on June 29th, 1927;

That he desires to practise law in the Province of Quebec after undergoing the usual examinations for admission to practice;

That at its meeting held on September 24th, 1927, the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec adopted a resolution approving the passing of an act by the Legislature authorizing the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit him to the practice of law, after final examinations;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the purposes above mentioned and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Henry Leo Silverstone amongst its members, <sup>Bar author-

Leo Silverstone. after he has undergone the regular examinations for admission to practise law, and is further authorized to allow him to practise law immediately after having successfully passed the said examinations.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
