



CHAPTER 6

An Act respecting the enlargement of the Court House and Gaol of the judicial district of Abitibi

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Public Works and Labour to enlarge the court house and gaol of the judicial district of Abitibi, in the town of Amos, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, at a cost, including the land required, of not more than fifty thousand dollars, payable out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province. Enlargement of court house and gaol at Amos, authorized.

2. In order to procure the land required for the said enlargement, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to acquire, by agreement or expropriation, the necessary immoveable properties and every immoveable right, charge, lease for occupation or emphyteutic lease, constituted rent or other rights affecting such properties. Acquisitions authorized.

Every expropriation necessitated for the purposes of this act shall be effected in conformity with the Quebec Railway Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 230), *mutatis mutandis*. Expropriation proceedings.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
