



CHAPTER 12

An Act to detach certain lots from the electoral district of Richelieu and to annex them to the municipality of the south part of the parish of St. Bernard, in the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The lots known and described under the numbers 1, 207, 208, 209, 212, 214, 216, 218, 219, 220 and 222 of the cadastre of the parish of St. Jude, which forms part of the municipality of the parish of St. Ours, in the electoral district of Richelieu, are detached from the said electoral district and annexed to the municipality of the south part of the parish of St. Bernard, in the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes.

2. The lots known and described under the numbers 386 to 429, inclusive, of the first range Sarasto, and the lots numbers 430 to 452, inclusive, of the second range Sarasto, of the cadastre for the parish of St. Ours, in the electoral district of Richelieu, are detached from the said electoral district and annexed to the municipality of the south part of the parish of St. Bernard, in the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes.

3. Paragraphs 65 and 74 of the table of electoral districts, R. S., c. 2, contained in section 7 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes, 1925, (Territorial Division Act) are amended accordingly.

4. This act shall come into force on the day which it may please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by proclamation.
