



CHAPTER 13

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1925, respecting
the Independence of the Legislature

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly,
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. A member of the Legislative Assembly appointed to one of the offices mentioned in section 66 of the Legislature Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 3) shall not be disqualified or re-elected, in certain event, qualified to sit nor require re-election by reason of such appointment.

2. Section 34 of the Legislature Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 3, 1925, chapter 3) is amended by adding thereto, after the word: "employment", in the third line thereof, the words: "rendering him disqualified to sit".

3. Section 66 of said act is amended by striking out the words: "if elected thereto while holding such office", in the eleventh and twelfth lines of subsection 1 thereof.

4. Section 72 of said act is amended by striking out the words: "but he may be re-elected if eligible under section 66", in the fifth line thereof.

5. Section 73 of said act is repealed.
