



CHAPTER 21

An Act to amend the Alcoholic Liquor Act

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 37:
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, c. 21.
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 23 of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised Sta- R. S., c. 37,
tutes, 1925, chapter 37) is amended by adding thereto, s. 23, am.
after the words: "alcoholic liquor", in the second line of
subsection 4 thereof, the words: "in virtue of a permit
issued by it or under the authority of section 49 or".

2. Section 37 of the said act, as amended by the act Id., s. 37,
16 George V, chapter 21, section 3, is again amended: am.

a. By replacing the sub-paragraph *a* of paragraph 8 of
the *Second Part* by the following:

"a. In the cities of Quebec and Montreal, three hundred Quebec and

b. By replacing paragraphs *a* and *b* of the *Third Part* by
the following:

"a. In the case of the death of the holder of the permit In case of

b. In the case of a change of premises, one hundred dol- In case of

and a sum equal to the duty payable upon the granting of

3. Section 42 of the said act, as amended by the act 16 George V, chapter 21, section 4, is again amended:

a. By replacing the word: "nine", in the sixth line of subsection 3 thereof, by the word: "eight";

b. By replacing the word: "nine", in the third line of subsection 4 thereof, by the word: "eight";

c. By adding to subsection 4 thereof the following paragraph:

Sale of wine
or beer.

"Nevertheless, no wine or beer may be sold in such hotels on holidays save at meals served between noon and ten o'clock in the evening.";

d. By inserting therein, after the word: "in", in the third line of subsection 6 thereof, the following words and figures: "subsections 1, 2 and 4 of".
