



CHAPTER 22

An Act to amend the Lands and Forests Act

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 44:
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, cc. 23,
of Quebec, enacts as follows: 24.

1. Section 56 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised R. S., c. 44, Statutes, 1925, chapter 44) is amended by replacing the s. 56, am. second paragraph thereof by the following:

"Lands forming part of a timber limit may also be sold Sale of cer-
in the same manner and for the same purposes, subject, tain lands
however, to an indemnity payable by the purchaser to the subject to

The extent and the description of the required land and Indemnity
the amount of such indemnity shall be fixed by mutual fixed by
agreement by the parties concerned, and, if not so fixed, it mutual
shall be determined, finally and without appeal, by the agreement,

terested party. The order-in-council authorizing the sale
shall mention the extent and the description of such land
and the amount of the indemnity thus fixed by mutual
agreement, or the fact that such extent, such description
and such amount shall be determined as hereinabove set
forth."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
