



CHAPTER 24

An Act respecting the sale of agricultural products

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

WHEREAS in order to further develop agriculture, it is Preamble.
expedient to assist in the preparing, classifying and
sale of agricultural products; to conserve and improve our
present markets, and to find new ones in this country, in
the United Kingdom and abroad;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. An amount of fifty thousand dollars shall be an-Amount to
nually placed at the disposal of the Department of Agri-improve,
culture, for the purposes mentioned in the preamble of this etc., mar-
act. Such sum shall be paid upon Order of the Lieutenant-kets, etc.
Governor in Council, out of the consolidated revenue fund.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
