



CHAPTER 25

An Act respecting Live Stock and Live Stock Products

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

Whereas the Parliament of Canada has passed "The Preamble.
Live Stock and Live Stock Products Act, 1923", contained
in the Statute 13-14 George V, chapter 18;

Whereas doubts have arisen as to the constitutionality
of certain provisions of such act and of the regulations
made thereunder, their object being within the jurisdic-
tion of the Legislature of this Province and *ultra vires* of
the powers of the Parliament of Canada;

Whereas it is in the public interest that the Government
of this Province should coöperate with that of Canada for
the carrying out of the provisions of such regulations; and

Whereas for such purpose it is expedient to remove the
above-mentioned doubts and to give force of law to the
provisions of these regulations in the Province of Quebec;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may from time Regulations
to time, by proclamation, order that from the date men- under
tioned therein the provisions of the regulations made under federal Live

replacement which may hereafter be made to the said act to have
and which are or may be within the jurisdiction of the force of law,
Legislature of this Province, shall, after their approval after ap-
by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, have force of law
in this Province to all intents and purposes, until such
regulations be repealed or cancelled by the Parliament of

Canada or the Governor-General in Council, as the case may be, or until the Legislature of this Province shall have adopted an act for the purposes within its jurisdiction relating to the same object.

Revocation
of approval. **2.** The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may, at his discretion and in the same manner, revoke the proclamation mentioned in the foregoing section 1, and, from the date mentioned in the proclamation revoking the first proclamation, the latter shall be null and void.

Coming into
force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
