



CHAPTER 26

An Act to amend the Agricultural Land Sales Act

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Agricultural Land Sales Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 77, 1925, chapter 77) is amended by adding thereto, after s. 60, added section 59 thereof, the following division and section:

"DIVISION VIII

"Premiums for clearing, ploughing and residence

"60. The Minister of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries may pay, out of the credits voted annually by the Legislature for such purpose, colonization premiums to encourage settlers to clear their lots and plough them and reside thereon. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may adopt all such regulations as he may deem expedient to determine the conditions to be fulfilled in order to earn such premiums."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
