



## CHAPTER 30

### An Act to amend the Game Laws

[Assented to, the 24th of February, 1927]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 86:  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly, 1926, c. 29.  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 6 of the Game Laws (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 86, chapter 86) is amended by adding thereto the following s. 6, am. subsection.

"5. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, Provisions for killing of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may order that the bear at any time of the year, for such period of time and in such electoral districts as he year. may, from time to time, determine. The Minister may then pay, out of the revenues derived from the carrying Reward. out of this act, a sum of fifteen dollars to any inhabitant of the Province of Quebec, who kills a bear and furnishes the said Minister with a certificate from a justice of the peace establishing that such person has made proof before him to his satisfaction, on oath, that he has killed a bear in one of the electoral districts mentioned in the order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and has shown him the bear or the bear's head with the scalp and ears intact, and that such justice of the peace, before granting the certificate, has caused the ears and scalp to be cut off the bear's head and burned."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
