



CHAPTER 38

An Act to amend the Education Act

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 133:
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, cc. 14,
of Quebec, enacts as follows: 40-43.

1. Section 373 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 133,
1925, chapter 133) is replaced by the following: s. 373, re-
placed.

"373. The commissioners or trustees of a school municipality, the territory of which wholly or partly covers that of several rural, city or town municipalities, shall, before fixing the rate of their annual assessment or of any special assessment, at a meeting called for the purpose, after public notice, examine and homologate the valuation roll in force in each of such rural, city or town municipalities, and, if they find that property is assessed at an amount higher in one than in another, they shall amend the different rolls so as to establish an equal basis of valuation of the taxable property in all parts of the school municipality. The collection rolls of the said school commissioners or trustees shall be made in accordance with the valuation rolls so homologated or amended, under pain of nullity. Valuation rolls. Equal basis of valuation. Collection rolls.

The superintendent, upon complaint by the ratepayers, may, if he deem it expedient, within fifteen days after the homologation or amending of such rolls as above, order a new valuation by three competent persons resident in the school municipality. New valuation.

2. Section 520 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: "one hundred and twenty-five dollars", in the third line of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "one hundred and fifty dollars". R. S., c. 133, s. 520, am.

R. S., c. 133, s. 523, am. **3.** Section 523 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: "one hundred and twenty-five dollars", in the third and fourth lines thereof, by the words: "one hundred and fifty dollars".

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
