



CHAPTER 39

An Act to amend the Education Act respecting Rural School Corporation Assistance

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 133:
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, cc. 14,
of Quebec, enacts as follows: 40-43.

1. The Education Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter R. S., c. 133,
133) is amended by adding thereto, after section 581 there- ss. 582 to
of, the following part and sections: 587, added.

"PART XI

"RURAL SCHOOL CORPORATION ASSISTANCE

"582. For the purposes of this Part, the words "rural school corporation" mean any school corporation of a population of not more than five thousand, whose territory does not form part of a city or town. "Rural school corporation".

"583. The Provincial Secretary may grant such financial assistance as he may deem necessary to any rural school corporation which erects a school in accordance with the regulations established by the Superintendent of Education and the Director of the Provincial Bureau of Health, upon the conditions set forth by this Part. Financial assistance.

"584. The financial assistance provided for by this Part shall be granted only subject to the condition that the school be built upon land belonging to a rural school corporation and that such school be and remain entirely its property. Idem.

Financial
assistance.

"585. The financial assistance granted may represent the entire cost of construction when such does not exceed twelve hundred dollars and the school is situated in a colonization centre. In all other cases, when the construction cost does not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars, the Provincial Secretary may, upon the conditions which he may deem fair and equitable, pay to the extent of two-thirds of the cost of such construction. The said assistance shall not extend to the purchase of the site, nor shall it extend to its enlargement or to the purchase of school equipment.

Special re-
gulations.

"586. The Provincial Secretary may, from time to time, make special regulations respecting the conditions connected with such assistance, and may change or cancel them if he deem it necessary.

Expendi-
tures.

"587. The expenditure incurred through the carrying out of this Part shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province."

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
