



## CHAPTER 45

An Act to amend the charter of the Polytechnic School

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 1 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 23, as amended by the acts 58 Victoria, chapter 26, section 1; 3 Edward VII, chapter 17, section 1, and 7 George V, chapter 30, section 1, is replaced by the following:

“**1.** The polytechnic school is incorporated under the name of “*La Corporation de l’Ecole Polytechnique*”, and the said corporation shall be composed:

1. Of the principal and director of the polytechnic school;
2. Of the Provincial Secretary;
3. Of five engineers, residing in Montreal, holding diplomas from the polytechnic school;
4. Of a representative of Montreal University; and
5. Of a member of the Roman Catholic Committee of the Council of Education, chosen by the said corporation.

The said corporation may associate unto itself other members, to the number of four, who, being donors, shall have complied with the conditions of the by-laws to be made respecting benefactors of the institution.”

**2.** Section 17 of the said act, as amended by the acts 57 Victoria, c. 3 Edward VII, chapter 17, section 4; 7 Edward VII, chapter 23, s. 17, am. 28, section 1; 8 Edward VII, chapter 31, section 1; 9 Edward VII, chapter 35, section 1; 1 George V (1911), chapter 30, section 2; 3 George V, chapter 26, section 1; 4 George V, chapter 26, section 1; 8 George V, chapter 41, section 1, and 11 George V, chapter 53, section 1, is further amended by replacing the word: “eighty”, in the fourth line thereof, by the words: “one hundred”.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
