



CHAPTER 49

An Act respecting the pensions of judges of the sessions,
police magistrates and district magistrates

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 145;
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, cc. 14,
of Quebec, enacts as follows: 51.

1. The Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 145,
chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto, after section s. 241a, ad-

“**241a.** From and after the first day of the month fol- Pension to
