



CHAPTER 50

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act respecting certain Recorders' Courts.

[Assented to, the 24th of February, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the R. S., c. 145:
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly 1926, cc. 14,
of Quebec, enacts as follows: 51.

1. Section 252 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised R. S., c. 145,

“The salary of the assistant-recorder, fixed by resolu- Salary.
tion of the council, shall be paid by the municipality for which he is appointed.”
