



CHAPTER 56

An Act to legalize certain acts effected under the *Parish and Fabrique Act*

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

WHEREAS the Roman Catholic Bishop of the diocese of Gaspé, the trustees administering the parishes and the freehold inhabitants elected, appointed or chosen in the said diocese, have applied and had recourse, in cases where the *Parish and Fabrique Act* (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 197) provides for the intervention or action of commissioners for the civil erection of parishes, to the "Commissioners for the civil erection of the parishes of the Roman Catholic diocese of Saint-Germain de Rimouski";

Whereas it is in the public interest to regularize such intervention of the Commissioners for the civil erection of the parishes of the diocese of Saint-Germain de Rimouski, and such regularization is asked for by the Ordinary of the diocese of Gaspé;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The acts effected for the objects contemplated by the *Parish and Fabrique Act*, before and by the Commissioners for the civil erection of the parishes of the Roman Catholic diocese of Saint-Germain de Rimouski, respecting the diocese of Gaspé, shall have the same validity and effect as if they had been done before and by the Commissioners for the civil erection of the parishes of the diocese of Gaspé, notwithstanding any absence of jurisdiction, provided that such acts be not otherwise voidable.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
