



CHAPTER 64

An Act to amend the Special Corporate Powers Act

[Assented to, the 24th of February, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Special Corporate Powers Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 227, 1925, chapter 227) is amended by adding thereto, after s. 14a, added division V thereof, the following division and section:

"DIVISION *va*

"SPECIAL POWERS OF CERTAIN RELIGIOUS CORPORATIONS

"**14a.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, religious communities, seminaries and colleges, duly incorporated and empowered to borrow and to hypothecate their immoveable property, shall have the right, subject to the authorization of the Ordinary having authority over them, to exercise the powers set forth in Division V of this act, and all the provisions of said Division V shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to everything done by such religious communities, seminaries and colleges in virtue of the powers conferred by this section." Powers given to communities, etc.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
