



## CHAPTER 75

### An Act to amend article 202 of the Municipal Code

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 202 of the Municipal Code is amended by Mun. Code, adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the fol- art. 202, am. lowing paragraph:
