



CHAPTER 75

An Act to amend article 202 of the Municipal Code

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 202 of the Municipal Code is amended by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

“Whenever the boundary fence, the construction, repair or preservation whereof is applied for, separates lands subject to rights exercised in common by several persons, and generally known under the name of “Cove” (“*Anse*”) or that of “Common” (“*Commune*”), from the bordering and abutting lands, or from the abutting lands only, the rural inspector, after visiting the place and hearing the interested parties, may order, by the decision to be rendered by him, that the work applied for under the first paragraph of this article shall be publicly given out to the lowest tenderer, after public notice, and he may apportion the cost of such work among the interested parties in proportion to the share for which each is responsible.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
