



CHAPTER 101

An Act to amend the charter of the Association of Accountants in Montreal

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

WHEREAS the Association of Accountants in Mont-Preamble.
real has, by its petition, represented that it was incorporated by an act of the Legislature of the Province of Quebec, 43-44 Victoria, chapter 88, which was amended by the act 60 Victoria, chapter 87, and has prayed that its said charter be amended in the manner hereinafter mentioned; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioner;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of the Change of
act 43-44 Victoria, chapter 88, the name of the company name.
shall be "The Society of Chartered Accountants of the
Province of Quebec" in English, and "*La Société des comp-
tables agréés de la province de Québec*", in French.

2. The alteration of its name shall not in any way im-Rights and
pair, alter, or affect the rights or liabilities of the Society, liabilities
or of any of its members, nor in any wise affect any not affected.
suit or proceedings now pending, or judgment existing
either by, in favour of, or against the said Society, which
proceedings or judgments, notwithstanding such change of
name, may be prosecuted, completed and enforced as if this
act had not been passed.

3. Section 4 of the act 43-44 Victoria, chapter 88, as 43-44 Vict.,

replaced by section 1 of the act 60 Victoria, chapter 87, is again replaced by the following:

Admission
fee.

"4. The amount to be paid by a member on his admission and the amount of the annual subscription shall be those fixed by the by-laws of the Society."

4. Section 9 of the said act is replaced by the following:

Admission
and expulsion.

"9. The Society may admit as members such persons as it sees fit; and it may expel any member for misconduct and violation of its rules and by-laws, on complaint and after enquiry; and, for that purpose, the council shall have power to examine and hear the parties and their witnesses on oath, which oath the president of the council or other officer of the Society presiding at such enquiry shall have the power to administer.

Designa-
tion.

Members of the Society only shall be entitled to use the designation of "Chartered Accountant" in English, or "*comptable agréé*" in French, and to use after their names the initials, "C. A."

Coming into
force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
