



CHAPTER 125

An Act to ratify by-law No. 47 of the municipality of the township of Grand Calumet, in the county of Pontiac

[Assented to, the 1st of April, 1927]

WHEREAS it has been represented by the petition of **Preamble.**

Daniel P. Burke, superintendent, George T. McGuire, superintendent, Daniel E. McLaughlin, electrician, and Joseph Razo, fireman, all of Calumet Island, in the electoral district of Pontiac, that Ottawa River Power Company, Limited, possesses in the Island of Calumet and in the village of Bryson on the Ottawa River, certain property on which large industrial improvements have been made;

Whereas nevertheless the corporation of the township of Grand Calumet in which most of the said development is situated has deemed fit to pass, on the 15th day of January, 1927, a by-law bearing No. 47 by which it granted to the said Ottawa River Power Company, Limited, a commutation of taxes for a period of ten years from such date, on the properties which the company may possess within its limits during the said term, so as to facilitate the exploitation of such industrial establishment, which will enure to the benefit of the locality and contribute largely to its development;

Whereas the said by-law was submitted for the approval of the municipal electors and has been unanimously approved; and

Whereas it is expedient to confirm the same and grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. 47 of the corporation of the township of **By-law confirmed, etc.**

Commuta-

Grand Calumet, in the electoral district of Pontiac, granting to the Ottawa River Power Company, Limited, a commutation of taxes, is hereby confirmed and declared valid and obligatory.

Coming into
force.
