



CHAPTER 127

An Act to ratify and confirm a trust agreement between Chaleurs Bay Mills and National Trust Company, Limited, and others and the title of National Trust Company, Limited, in trust, to the timber limits conveyed to it thereunder

[Assented to, the 24th of February, 1927]

WHEREAS National Trust Company, Limited, a body politic and corporate, duly incorporated under the Ontario Companies' Act by letters patent under the Great Seal of the Province of Ontario, having its head office in the city of Toronto in the said Province, duly authorized to carry on business in the Province of Quebec and having an office and chief place of business for the Province of Quebec, in the city of Montreal, has, by its petition, represented: Preamble.

That by a trust agreement between Chaleurs Bay Mills, the said National Trust Company, Limited, International Paper Company and Canadian International Paper Company, executed on the 7th of October, 1926, before George Carlyle Marler, Notary Public, under No. 3994 of his minutes, certain timber limits held under license from the Province of Quebec were conveyed by the said Chaleurs Bay Mills to the said National Trust Company, Limited, in trust;

That doubts have arisen as to the sufficiency of the notices given in connection with the original disposal at public auction of certain of the said timber limits and as to the validity of the title to such timber limits and the subsequent transfers thereof;

That it is expedient, in view of such doubts, that the said trust agreement and the title of National Trust Company, Limited, in trust, to the said timber limits be ratified and confirmed and declared valid for all legal purposes; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

valid. **1.** The trust agreement between Chaleurs Bay Mills, National Trust Company, Limited, International Paper Company and Canadian International Paper Company, executed on the 7th of October, 1926, before George Carlyle Marler, Notary Public, under No. 3994 of his minutes, and the title of the said National Trust Company, Limited, in trust, to the timber limits conveyed to it under the said trust agreement, are hereby ratified and confirmed and declared valid for all legal purposes.
