



## CHAPTER 144

An Act to authorize Victor M. Lynch-Staunton to practise  
the legal profession

*[Assented to, the 24th of February, 1927.]*

**W**HEREAS Victor M. Lynch-Staunton, advocate, of Preamble.  
the city of Montreal, in the Province of Quebec, has,  
by his petition, represented:

That he has passed his final Bar examination to practise,  
in July, 1926;

That he passed the examination for admission to study  
in two parts, as follows: Sciences, January, 1924, Letters,  
July, 1925;

That he is a graduate in law from the University of  
Montreal, having received the degree of Bachelor of Law in  
May, 1926;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of  
Quebec has granted his request asking for permission to  
present a bill which would authorize him to exercise his  
profession as soon as such bill would come into force;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for the passing of an  
act for the purposes aforesaid, and it is expedient to grant  
his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** Victor M. Lynch-Staunton is permitted to practise V.M.Lynch-  
as an advocate as soon as this act shall come into force. Staunton  
authorized  
to practise.
- 2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
sanction. force.
