



CHAPTER 17

An Act to amend the Property Transfer Duty Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Property Transfer Duty Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 28) is amended: R. S., c. 28,
s. 2, am.

a. By replacing the words: "sheriff of the district", in the second line of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "Revenue Branch, at Quebec";

b. By striking out the third paragraph thereof.

2. The said act is amended by inserting therein, after section 3 thereof, the following sections: Idem, ss. 4,
5 and 6,
added.

"4. The registrar of any registration division to whom there is presented, for registration, a transfer of property made in the manner indicated in section 2 of this act, shall give notice thereof within fifteen days to the Comptroller of Provincial Revenue stating the name in full and address of the acquirer, the purchase price and the description of the property. The registrar shall be entitled to a fee of two dollars for such notice, payable by the Revenue Branch. Notice of registration to Comptroller of Provincial Revenue.

"5. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make such regulations as he may deem necessary for the carrying out of this act. Carrying out of this act.

"6. Under the immediate direction of the Provincial Treasurer, the Comptroller of Provincial Revenue shall have charge of the carrying out of this act." Idem.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
