



CHAPTER 17

An Act to amend the Property Transfer Duty Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Property Transfer Duty Act (Revised R. S., c. 28,
Statutes, 1925, chapter 28) is amended: s. 2, am.

a. By replacing the words: "sheriff of the district", in
the second line of the second paragraph thereof, by the
words: "Revenue Branch, at Quebec";

b. By striking out the third paragraph thereof.

2. The said act is amended by inserting therein, after Idem, ss. 4,
section 3 thereof, the following sections: 5 and 6,
added.

"4. The registrar of any registration division to whom Notice of
