



CHAPTER 59

An Act to amend the Architects' Act

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 6 of the Architects' Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 220, 1925, chapter 220) is amended by adding thereto, after s. 6, am. sub-paragraph *b* of subsection 1 thereof, the following sub-paragraph:

"*c.* Any person who has regularly attended the courses on architecture in the School of Fine Arts of Quebec or in the School of Fine Arts of Montreal, and has successfully undergone the examinations therein on the subjects determined by the regulations of either of such schools, and who has served one year of studentship under indenture in an architect's office, and who, upon presentation of a certificate from the examiner, appointed under section 9, establishing that he has also successfully passed the examination upon the professional practice, and, after accomplishing these formalities, has obtained the diploma of architect granted by one or other of such schools and has had his name registered by the secretary of the association and has paid the secretary of the said association the admission fees and annual dues."

2. This act shall apply to students of architecture of the School of Fine Arts of Montreal who completed their studies at such school in the month of May, 1925, if they come within the conditions above set forth.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
