



## CHAPTER 84

### An Act to amend the charter of the Rouyn Mines Railway Company

*[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]*

**W**HEREAS the Rouyn Mines Railway Company (hereinafter called "the company") has represented that it would be in the interest of the company to change the name under which it was incorporated by the act 15 George V, chapter 110; Preamble.

Whereas a petition has been presented by the said company praying for the passing of an act to amend the said charter for the purposes hereinafter described; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of the act 15 George V, chapter 110, the name of the company shall be as follows: "National Transcontinental Railway Branch Lines Company". Change of name.

**2.** The alteration of its name shall not affect the rights or obligations of the company; all proceedings may be commenced or continued by or against the company under its new name that might have been commenced or continued by or against the company under its former name. Obligations, etc., not affected.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
