



CHAPTER 86

An Act respecting the municipalization of the ferry service
over the Saguenay river between the town of Chicoutimi
and the village of Ste. Anne

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

WHEREAS the corporation of the village of Ste. Anne Preamble.
has, by its petition, represented:

That, in order to secure and improve the means of communication between the village of Ste. Anne, the township of Tremblay and the town of Chicoutimi, it is expedient and necessary to authorize it, alone or jointly with such town, to municipalize the ferry service over the river Saguenay, between these places;

Whereas the town of Chicoutimi has, by resolution of the 18th of January, 1926, consented to the corporation of the village of Ste. Anne operating such service alone;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the act 4 Edward VII, chapter 62, Establishment of ferry-boats between Ste. Anne and Chicoutimi, authorized.
section 18, the corporation of the village of Ste. Anne is authorized to establish, under its control and administration, a service of ferry-boats for crossing the river Saguenay, between the village of Ste. Anne, the township of Tremblay and the town of Chicoutimi, for twenty-five years starting from the 1st of May, 1926, and to acquire or lease everything required to attain this object.

2. The number and hours of crossings as well as the Crossings and tariff.
tariff shall be regulated by the village of Ste. Anne and the town of Chicoutimi.

3. Whenever the councils of both these municipalities Reference in

case of dispute. do not agree, the dispute shall be submitted at the request of one of the municipalities to the Quebec Public Service Commission.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
