



CHAPTER 94

An Act to amend the charter of The Homœopathic Hospital of Montreal

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by The Homœopathic Hospital of Montreal, incorporated by an act of the Province of Quebec, 4 Edward VII, chapter 96;

Whereas in section 1 of the said act it is provided that The Homœopathic Hospital of Montreal shall have power to receive, hold and enjoy moveable and immoveable property of all kinds by any title whatsoever, provided that the immoveable property shall not exceed, in annual value, the sum of twenty thousand dollars;

Whereas The Homœopathic Hospital of Montreal has purchased land in the city of Montreal on which to erect new hospital buildings, the annual value of which will exceed the sum of twenty thousand dollars;

Whereas it is desirable that section 1 of the said act be amended;

Whereas it has prayed for the passing of an act for the above-mentioned purposes; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of the act 4 Edward VII, chapter 96, is ^{4 Ed. VII, c. 96, s. 1, replaced.} replaced by the following:

"1. The several persons hereinbefore named, and all other persons who now are or who may hereafter be associated with them for the purposes of this act, and their successors, are constituted a body politic and corporate under the name of "The Homœopathic Hospital of Montreal", and shall have power to receive, hold and enjoy moveable and ^{Constitution of corporation.} ^{Name and powers.}

immoveable property of all kinds by any title whatsoever, whether by gift, purchase, devise, will, lease or otherwise, and such property to hypothecate as security for loans or other purposes and the same also to let, lease, exchange, sell or otherwise alienate or dispose of, without prejudice to such trust and conditions as may be declared concerning the same in the title under which they may be held; provided always that the immoveable property shall not exceed, in annual value, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, and that an annual report of their operations be made to the Provincial Secretary."

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
