



CHAPTER 121

An Act to ratify by-law No. 22 of the municipality of
West Templeton

[Assented to, the 24th of March, 1926]

WHEREAS the Canadian International Paper Company Preamble.
has, by its petition, represented that on the 16th day of December, 1925, a by-law bearing No. 22 was passed by the municipal council of West Templeton which granted unto said Canadian International Paper Company, its successors and assigns, a fixing of valuation for municipal purposes and other rights and privileges for a period of twenty years, on the lands, mills, buildings, machinery, plant and improvements, extensions and additions which may be made thereto, connected with the construction and operation of a pulp and paper mill and accessories within said municipality;

That these concessions were made to the company in view of the establishment in the municipality of West Templeton of an industry which will be of considerable benefit to the municipality and give employment to a great number of people and contribute largely toward its development and progress;

That it is expedient in view of the law in such case that the by-law be confirmed by the Legislature in order to give it force and effect;

That the school commissioners for the school municipality of West Templeton within whose territory the said works will be, at a meeting held on the 21st day of December, 1925, approved insofar as they were concerned the said by-law;

That under the circumstances it is expedient that the by-law be confirmed; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of

the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

By-law No. 22, ratified. **1.** By-law No. 22 of the municipality of West Templeton, granting the Canadian International Paper Company, its successors and assigns, a fixed municipal valuation and other rights and privileges, is hereby confirmed and declared valid and obligatory, but the valuation for school purposes shall be three hundred thousand dollars for the first year, four hundred thousand dollars for the second year to the fifth year inclusive, five hundred thousand dollars from the sixth to the tenth year, seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars from the eleventh to the fifteenth year, and one million dollars from the sixteenth year to the twentieth year.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
