



CHAPTER 126

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Georges Larouche, of Quebec, to the practice of the legal profession, after examination.

[Assented to, the 11th of March, 1926]

WHEREAS Georges Larouche, law student, of Quebec, Preamble.
has, by his petition, represented:

That he is a bachelor of arts; that he studied law at Laval University, from September, 1922, to June, 1925; that he successfully passed the examination for the licentiate in law, and obtained the degree of bachelor of law;

That he was indentured to Mtre. Arthur Gagné, advocate, of Quebec, on the 8th of May, 1923, and regularly followed his patron's office practice as a clerk;

That he obtained his diploma for admission to the study of law on the 10th of January, 1924;

That he cannot practise the profession of advocate immediately, even if he be successful in the final examination for admission to practice, as he was only admitted to study in January, 1924, and began his clerkship only on the 8th of May, 1923;

Whereas the want of means prevented him from obtaining his diploma of admission to study law in time, and he had to delay being indentured through unavoidable causes;

Whereas these facts were brought to the notice of the General Council of the Bar of the Province and the said council granted the request to allow him to present a bill at the next session of the Legislature, for the purpose of admitting him to the practice of law, after examination, immediately after the passing of such bill;

Whereas he has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of

the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Coming into
force.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Georges Larouche among its members, and to allow him to practise law, after examination.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
