



CHAPTER 131

An Act ratifying the adoption of Terence Francis Moore and changing his name to that of Terence Francis Moore Mitchell

[Assented to, the 24th of March, 1926]

WHEREAS Terence Francis Moore, of the city and district of Montreal, clerk, has, by his petition, represented that he is of the full age of majority and was born of the marriage of the late Charles F. Moore with Antonia Pelletier who subsequently became the wife of Walter George Mitchell, of the city and district of Montreal, advocate and King's Counsel; that his mother is now deceased, and that he was adopted by the said Walter George Mitchell by deed passed before Lionel Joron, Notary Public, on December 31st, 1925; Preamble.

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that such adoption be ratified and full legal effect be given thereto; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The agreement of adoption between the said Walter George Mitchell and Terence Francis Moore, passed before Lionel Joron, Notary Public, on December 31st, 1925, is ratified and confirmed and is declared to create, between the said Terence Francis Moore and the said Walter George Mitchell and the latter's children to all intents and for all purposes whatever, the same legal effect and relation as if the said Terence Francis Moore had been born of the marriage of his mother with the said Walter George Mitchell and was one of the descendents of the latter. Agreement of adoption of Dec. 31st, 1925, ratified.

2. The name of the said Terence Francis Moore is hereby changed to that of Terence Francis Moore Mitchell. Change of name.

Legal effect
of contracts,
etc.

3. All contracts, covenants, agreements, legacies, bequests and gifts entered into or made by or in favour of the said Terence Francis Moore and all certificates and diplomas issued to him in the name of Terence Francis Moore Mitchell shall have the same legal effect as if they had been entered into, made by or issued to him under the name of Terence Francis Moore.

Coming into

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
