

dom, but, together with their historic rights, possess special civil rights, and in particular retain their own French laws;

Whereas from the standpoint of their collectivity, dignity requires that their national festival, St. John the Baptist's Day, the date whereof is the 24th of June, be declared a holiday;

Whereas they have long prayed for this and it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph 24 of article 36 of the Revised Statutes, R. S., 36, § 1909, is amended by inserting therein, after the word: ^{24, am.} "Ascension", in the second line of sub-paragraph *c* thereof, the words: "the 24th of June, St. John the Baptist's Day".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}

CHAP. 12

An Act to detach certain lots from the electoral district of Beauce and to annex them to the municipality of the parish of Saint-Louis-de-Gonzague, in the electoral district of Dorchester, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes

[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec enacts as follows:

1. The lots numbered 7 to 23, inclusively, of the eleventh range of the township of Metgermette-North, on the official plan and book of reference of such township, are detached from the municipality of the north part of the township of Metgermette-North, in the electoral district of Beauce, and annexed, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes, to the electoral district of Dorchester, where they shall form part of the municipality of the parish of Saint-Louis-de-Gonzague. ^{Certain lots to form part of the municipality of St-Louis-de-Gonzague.}

2. Paragraphs 5 and 18 of the table of electoral districts, R. S., 65, §§ contained in article 65 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as ^{5 and 18, am.}

enacted by the act 13 George V, chapter 13, section 1, are amended accordingly.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 13

An Act to detach certain lots from the electoral district of Dorchester and to annex them to the parish of Saint-Damien-de-Buckland, in the electoral district of Bellechasse, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes

[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The lots known and designated under the numbers twenty-one-A, twenty-one-B, twenty-one-C, twenty-two, twenty-three-A, twenty-three-B, twenty-three-C, twenty-four-A, twenty-four-B, twenty-four-C, and twenty-four-D, of the fourth range of the township of Buckland, heretofore forming part of the parish of Saint-Malachie-de-Frampton, are, by the present act, detached, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes, from the electoral district of Dorchester and annexed to the electoral district of Bellechasse, where they shall form part of the parish of Saint-Damien-de-Buckland.

2. Paragraphs 7 and 18 of the table of electoral districts, contained in article 65 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 13 George V, chapter 13, section 1, are amended accordingly.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
