5. Article 999 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted R. S., 999, by the act 11 George V, chapter 26, section 1, is amended: ^{am.}

a. By striking out the word: "cartridges", in the seventh line thereof;

b. By adding thereto, after the word: "things", in the eighth line thereof, the words: "but such word shall not mean cartridges".

6. Article 1006 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted R. S., 1006, by the act 11 George V, chapter 26, section 1, is amended ^{am.} by adding thereto, after the fifth paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

CHAP. 26

An Act to amend the Motor Vehicle Act

[Assented to, the 3rd of April, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 5 of the act 14 George V, chapter 24, is 14 Geo. V,

c. 24, s. 5, am. amended by replacing the words: "exceeds ten thousand pounds, where the vehicle is equipped entirely or partially with non-pneumatic tires, or which exceeds twelve thousand pounds, where the vehicle is equipped entirely with pneumatic tires", in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth lines of paragraph 4 thereof, by the words: "exceeds the limits established by the present act and by the regulations made thereunder, to circulate on a public highway outside of cities and towns".

14 Geo. V, c. 24, s. 43, am. Protection of roads. **2.** Section 43 of the said act is amended by inserting therein, after the first paragraph thereof, the following: "Any municipal corporation shall have the right to prohibit the passage over a municipal road which belongs to it, by means of notices or gates, to protect it while thawing out or during a rainy period, for such period of time as it may think necessary, provided such municipal road does not form part of a provincial highway or of a regional highway, and is not a road which the Minister of Roads has undertaken to maintain by virtue of a contract."

14 Geo. V, c. 24, s. 51, am. **3.** Section 51 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the word: "offender", in the second line of paragraph 2 thereof, the words: "or for which he is condemned".

14 Geo. V, c. 24, s. 59, am. **4.** Section 59 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the word: "vehicles", in the second line of sub-paragraph 4, thereof, the following words: "save to protect the same while thawing out or during a rainy period".

14 Geo. V, c. 24, s. 60, am. **5.** Section 60 of the said act is amended by replacing the words: "exceeds ten thousand pounds, where the vehicle is equipped entirely or partially with non-pneumatic tires, or which exceeds twelve thousand pounds, where the vehicle is equipped entirely with pneumatic tires", in the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth lines of paragraph 4 thereof, by the words: "exceeds the limits established by the present act and by the regulations made thereunder, to circulate on a public highway outside of cities and towns".

14 Geo. V, c. 24, s. 68, am. **6.** Section 68 of the said act is amended by adding, immediately after sub-paragraph *u* of paragraph 1 thereof, the following sub-paragraphs:

Change date of licenses, etc. "v. Change the date of licenses and registrations, and modify the fees payable for the registrations made or the licenses issued on or after the first of September, each year;

"w. Take means to ascertain the accidents caused or suffered by motor vehicles, and take the measures required to prevent another accident from happening at the same place or from being caused by the same person." Ascertain accidents, etc.

CHAP. 27

An Act to amend the Gasoline Act

[Assented to, the 3rd of April, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the act 14 George V, chapter 25, is 14 Geo. V, c. 25, s. 4, am. amended by replacing the word: "two", in the third line of paragraph 1 thereof, by the word: "three".

2. This act shall come into force on the first day of April, Coming into force. 1925.

CHAP. 28

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting taxes upon corporations

[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1346 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the acts 10 George V, chapter 23, section 3, and 12 R. S., 1346, am. George V, chapter 33, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs:

"Doing business in this Province" and "carrying on any undertaking, trade or business therein", when these expressions relate to an incorporated company, mean: business in this Province "Carrying on any undertaking, trade or business therein" and exercising any of its corporate rights, powers or objects in the Province. Nevertheless, the taking of orders, the purchase or the sale of merchandise and other effects, by means of travellers or by mail, shall not be interpreted as trade or business therein.
