An Act to amend the Quebec Game Laws

[Assented to, the 3rd of April, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- R. S., 2310, **1.** Article 2310 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted
am. by the act 7 George V, chapter 26, section 1, and amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 31, section 1, by the Order-in-Council No. 589 of the 6th of April 1920, by the act 11 George V, chapter 44, section 1, by the Order-in-Council No. 521 of the 11th of April 1921, and by the act 12 George V, chapter 45, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, after paragraph 2 thereof, the following paragraph:
- To hunt,
etc., deer. “2a. To hunt, kill or take deer at any time of the year, two hours after sunset and one hour before sunrise, on penalty of a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, per head.”
- R. S., 2312, **2.** Article 2312 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted
am. by the act 7 George V, chapter 26, section 1, and amended by the acts 8 George V, chapter 36, section 1; 9 George V, chapter 31, section 4, and 11 George V, chapter 44, section 3, is again amended by adding thereto, at the end of subparagraph *b* of paragraph 1, the following words: “and the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may determine the places where it shall be forbidden to use dogs to do such hunting”.
- R. S., 2316, **3.** Article 2316 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted
am. by the act 7 George V, chapter 26, section 1, and as amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 31, section 3, is again amended by replacing the figures: “1925”, in the third line of the first paragraph of paragraph 1 thereof, by the figures: “1930”.
- Coming into
force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
