CHAP. 75

An Act to amend the act respecting the acquisition and alienation of immoveable property by corporations and persons in mortmain

[Assented to, the 3rd of April, 1925]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 5a of the act 8 George V, chapter 77, as enact- 8 Geo. V, c. ed by the act 13 George V, chapter 74, section 1, is amend- 77, s. 5a, ed: _{am.}

a. By adding thereto, after the word: "mortmain", in the eighth line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "whether dissolved or not";

b. By inserting therein, after the first paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"In the case of a corporation or persons in mortmain ^{Corpora-} having sold in portions an immoveable which was ac- ^{tions or per-} quired without authorization, when an authorization was ^{sons in} necessary, to several purchasers, any purchaser of one of _{mortmain.} such portions may request a permit in the name of the corporation or persons in mortmain, whether dissolved or not, ratifying the acquisition of the whole immoveable by the corporation or persons in mortmain, and such ratification shall avail for all the purchasers of the other parts of the immoveable."
