An Act to allow the city of Montreal to exempt the Society of the Knights of Columbus and its affiliated societies from all municipal taxes in Montreal

[Assented to, the 3rd of April, 1925]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Knights of Columbus, a foreign corporation, authorized to carry on its affairs in this Province, has, by its petition, represented that it carries on an educational and philanthropic work, and for such purpose it finds it necessary to install and maintain establishments in several places in the city of Montreal and to assimilate its properties to those of educational establishments and institutions as regards the exemption from taxes for municipal purposes;

That the properties of the Knights of Columbus in the city of Montreal are held by affiliated societies or clubs called: *Association Colombienne de St. Henri Inc.*, Metropolitan Columbus Association, *la Compagnie de Construction Maisonneuve Limitée*, *la Compagnie de Construction Lafontaine Limitée*;

That each of these holds immoveables for the Knights of Columbus;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Exemption of Knights of Columbus from taxation.

1. The city of Montreal is authorized to enact by a resolution of its council that the buildings, lands, and other immoveables held, occupied and possessed by the Knights of Columbus or its affiliated companies, *l'Association Colombienne de St. Henri Inc.*, Metropolitan Columbus Association, *la Compagnie de Construction Maisonneuve Limitée*, and *la Compagnie de Construction Lafontaine Limitée*, in the city of Montreal, shall be exempted from municipal taxes.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
