An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to allow Isidore Charness to practise law.

[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]

WHEREAS Isidore Charness, of the city and district of Preamble. Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That he has successfully passed all examinations prescribed by the Bar of this Province to admit him as one of its members, namely, the examinations for admission to study, in Science in January, 1923, and in Letters in January, 1924, and the examinations for admission to practice, in July, 1924;

That notwithstanding the fact that he has passed all these examinations he will nevertheless be unable to practise his profession until January, 1927, the time when the period of his clerkship will have expired;

That, due to his straightened financial circumstances and other reasons stated in his petition to the Bar, he was unable to present himself for the examinations for the admission to study and consequently was also unable to indenture himself with an advocate, at the proper time;

That on September 26th, 1924, the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec authorized him to submit a bill to the Legislature praying to be allowed to practise the legal profession immediately after the sanction of the act;

Whereas the said Isidore Charness has prayed for the passing of an act for the above purposes; and it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Isidore Charness to practise law immediately.
2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
