**1.** The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Robert Fiset among its members, and to grant him the necessary license for the practice of medicine in the Province of Quebec, after he has successfully undergone the 3rd, 4th and 5th year examinations before the Medical Board.

#### C H A P. 170

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Adrien Lebrun to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics.

*[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]*

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Adrien Lebrun, of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition represented:

That he was admitted as a medical student in September 1913 to Laval University of Montreal and attended the medical course of the said university for the regular five years;

That he suspended his studies for five years through ill health and to do military service;

That the University of Montreal granted him his degree of Doctor of Medicine in June 1923;

That he began his course at the said university without passing the examinations for admission to the study of medicine;

That he possesses the qualifications required to practise medicine but cannot receive a license to practise in the Province of Quebec without special authorization from the Legislature;

That he obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec on the 24th of September, 1924, to the passing of a bill to authorize such College to admit him amongst its members and to grant

him the license required to practise his profession, after undergoing certain examinations required by the said College;

Whereas the said Adrien Lebrun has prayed for the passing of an act to that effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Adrien Lebrun among its members and to grant him the necessary license for the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics in the Province of Quebec, after he shall have undergone the first, second, third, fourth and fifth year examinations, before the Medical Board.

## CHAP. 171

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Robert Alexander Hart to the practice of dental surgery, after final examination

*[Assented to, the 4th of March, 1925]*

**W**HEREAS Robert Alexander Hart, of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

Preamble.

That he is a graduate of the University of Toronto, and holds degrees of doctor of dental surgery from that university, and also holds the licentiate of dental surgery from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons, Toronto, dated 16th of May, 1919;

That he has occupied and satisfactorily filled the position of superintendent of the Dental Department of the Montreal General Hospital at Montreal, and has occupied the position teaching dentistry to the McGill University dental students, between the dates, 1st of July, 1919, and 15th of September, 1924;

That he is now residing in the city of Montreal and desires to continue practice there;

That he has passed the preliminary examination required by the Quebec College of Dental Surgeons;
