CHAP. 17

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
security to be given by public officers

[Assented to, the 15th of February, 1924]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section fifth of chapter fifth of title third of the R.S., 614*a*, Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by inserting therein, 614*b*, added, after article 614 thereof, the following articles:

Security of public officer as guarantee for deputy. **"614a.** The security given by a public officer shall be a guarantee also of the actions and omissions of the deputy appointed by him before or after he has furnished such security.

Idem. **"614b.** Such security shall be a guarantee also of the actions and omissions of the deputy in the performance of the duties of his office, after the death or resignation of the officer who appointed him; nevertheless, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may require, upon the death or resignation of a public officer, that the deputy appointed by the latter furnish new security."

Reservation. **2.** This act shall not affect the presently existing security of public officers.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 18

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting Agents-General for the Province

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 689, am. **1.** Article 689 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the acts 9 George V, chapter 16, section 3, and 10 George V, chapter 19, section 1, is again amended by striking out, in the second line thereof, the words: "to the Agent-General for the Province in the United Kingdom".

7 Geo. V, c. 16, s. 6, am. **2.** Section 6 of the act 7 George V, chapter 16, as amended by the acts 9 George V, chapter 16, section 2; 10 George V, chapter 19, section 2, and 10 George V, chapter 20, section 1, is again amended by striking out, in the third line of the second paragraph thereof, the words: "the Agent-General for the Province in the United Kingdom".
