An Act respecting tuberculosis and infantile mortality
in the Province

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Establishment and maintenance of anti-tuberculous and puericultural dispensaries.

1. For the purpose of more effectively combatting tuberculosis and infantile mortality in this Province, the Director of the Provincial Bureau of Health shall, under the direction and control of the Provincial Secretary, take the necessary steps to provide for the establishment and maintenance of anti-tuberculous and puericultural dispensaries and to put into operation any other means calculated to attain the proposed objects.

Payment authorized.

2. In order to defray the expenses to be incurred in carrying out the provisions of section 1, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund, for a period of five years, a sum not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars per annum.

Maximum.

Requisition by Provincial Secretary.

3. The Provincial Secretary, from time to time as monies are required for the above purposes, shall forward to the Provincial Treasurer a requisition, stating the amount required and the special objects for which the sums are intended in each instance; and the Provincial Treasurer is authorized to pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund, the sums so authorized, to the extent fixed by section 2.

Payment by Provincial Treasurer.

Coming into force.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
