

**11.** The lease of any house or part of a house, used for the purposes or any of the purposes aforesaid, shall be considered as null and void, save that the owner or lessor may invoke it in any legal proceedings to expel the lessee.

**12.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## C H A P . 8 0

### An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure

*[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 5 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by striking out paragraph 4 thereof.

**2.** Article 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by striking out the second paragraph thereof.

**3.** Article 37 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the act 1 George V (1911), chapter 50, section 1, is again amended by replacing the words and numbers: "of Articles 2710, 2711 and 2712 of the Revised Statutes", in the fourth and fifth lines thereof, by the words and numbers: "of Articles 3510, 3511 and 3512 of the Revised Statutes, 1909".

**4.** Article 73 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the acts 1 George V (1911), chapter 50, section 2; 7 George V, chapter 54, section 1, and 13 George V, chapter 78, section 2, is again amended by striking out paragraph 1a thereof.

**5.** Article 73a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as enacted by the act 7 George V, chapter 54, section 2, is repealed.

**6.** Article 124 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by replacing the words and numbers: "of Articles 5720 to 5727 of the Revised Statutes", in the fourth line of the fourth paragraph thereof, by the words and numbers: "of Articles 7544 to 7551 of the Revised Statutes, 1909".

C. C. P., art. 598, am. **7.** Article 598 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the act 13 George V, chapter 79, section 1, is again amended by replacing the words and numbers: "Articles 1743 to 1748 of the Revised Statutes", in the first and second lines of paragraph 12 thereof, by the words and numbers: "Articles 2091 to 2097 of the Revised Statutes, 1909".

C. C. P., art. 1157, am. **8.** Article 1157 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by striking out the words: "of review or", in the first line of the second paragraph thereof.

Coming into force. **9.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

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## C H A P . 8 1

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting  
discharge of the order for advisement

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C. P., art. 536a, enacted. **1.** The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by inserting therein, after article 536 thereof, the following article:

Discharge of order for advisement, etc. **"536a.** No order for advisement may be discharged, and no order having the effect of preventing the rendering of a judgment may be issued, unless such order of discharge or other order sets forth at length the reasons therefor. The prothonotary shall make a report to the Chief Justice or Acting Chief Justice, as the case may be, notifying him of such order and of the reasons therefor, and shall give notice thereof to the attorneys of the parties."
