An Act to amend the act 8 George V, chapter 84, respecting
the contract between the city of Montreal and the
Montreal Tramways Company

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

WHEREAS the Montreal Tramways Company has, by Preamble.
its petition, represented that it is in the interests of
the company, and of the city of Montreal, that its contract
with the city of Montreal contained in Schedule "A" of
the act 8 George V, chapter 84, be amended; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" of the act 8 George V, chapter 84, is ^{8 Geo. V, c.} amended by inserting therein, after article 25 thereof, the ^{84, Sch. A,} following article:

"*Article 25a.*—Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding article (25), the company shall have the right to sell that part of its system of tramways known as the "Terminal Division", provided that a line be constructed in the same direction, for the purpose of furnishing a service as nearly similar as possible to that furnished by the existing line, before the discontinuance of the present service, in the municipalities served by the said line, under such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Commission."

2. The city of Montreal is authorized to open and widen Boyce and Hochelaga streets across Prefontaine, Maison-neuve and Mercier wards. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, these improvements shall be made in accordance with the provisions of articles 421 and following of the city charter and its amendments.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
