

C H A P. 105

An Act to amend the charter of Beauharnois Electric Company, Limited

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Beauharnois Electric Company, Limited, has, by its petition, represented that it is in the interest of the company that its charter be amended; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

4 Geo. V, c. 111, s. 10, replaced.

1. Section 10 of the act 4 George V, chapter 111, is replaced by the following:

Territory in which business may be carried on.

“10. Notwithstanding the provisions of section “B” of the letters patent, ratified by this act, the company shall have the right to carry on business only in the counties of Argenteuil, Huntingdon, Beauharnois, Chateauguay, Laprairie, Soulanges, Vaudreuil, Napierville, Iberville, St. John’s, Missisquoi and Two Mountains, and may enter upon and construct, under and over roads, streets and highways in the said counties, all such pipes, poles, lines, conduits and other installations and constructions as may be necessary for the purposes of its business, provided that the company shall be responsible for all damages that it may occasion, and shall replace the streets and public roads in their original state at its expense.”

Necessary construction authorized.

Proviso.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 106

An Act to amend the charter of the Vercheres, Chambly and Laprairie Tramways Company

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Vercheres, Chambly and Laprairie Tramways Company has, by its petition, represented:

That by reason of the present financial conditions, it will be unable to begin and complete the construction of its railway within the time fixed by its charter;

That such period of time should be extended; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer;
 Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

An Act to amend the charter of The Montreal Metropolitan Commission

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

WHEREAS The Montreal Metropolitan Commission has, Preamble. by its petition, represented that it is in its interest as well as in the interest of the municipalities over which its control extends that the acts 11 George V, chapter 140; 12 George V, chapters 123 and 124, and 13 George V, chapter 105, be amended and that more extended powers be vested in it in order to make its action more effective; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its petition;
 Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:
