

held by the corporation, the names of its officers and a copy of its rules and by-laws.

5. The Reverend Fathers Léonidas Hudon, Joseph-Papin Archambault, Louis Héroux, Hugues Lefebvre and Léon Sigouin, all members of the Society of Jesus, hereinabove mentioned, shall be a provisional board of management in charge of the exercise of all the powers and rights of the corporation until the organization of the corporation is provided for by the by-laws and regulations to be adopted.

6. In the case of dissolution or extinction of the corporation, its affairs shall be liquidated in the manner provided by the laws in force; and, its debts paid, its surplus assets, if any, to return to the Society of Jesus, incorporated by the Quebec statute, 50 Victoria, chapter 28.

7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 123

An Act to amend the charter of *Les Révérends Pères du Très-Saint-Sacrement de Québec*

[Assented to, the 15th of February, 1924]

WHEREAS *Les Pères du Très-Saint-Sacrement de Québec*, Preamble, incorporated by the act 11 George V, chapter 155, have, by their petition, and with the consent of His Eminence the Cardinal Archbishop of Quebec, prayed for the passing of an act to amend the above mentioned act, in such a way as to dispense with certain consent required and certain control established by the said act; to replace section 5 of the said act by another which will give effect to appointments by the Superior-General of *Les Pères du Très-Saint-Sacrement*; and to settle in a different way what shall take place in case of dissolution of the corporation;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioners;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph *b* of section 4 of the act 11 George V, chapter 155, is replaced by the following:

"*b.* have and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ordinary civil corporations;"

2. Section 5 of the said act is replaced by the following:

"5. The corporation shall be directed and administered by a council of administration composed of the Superior, the Vicar and the *Consulteur* of the Convent of *Les Religieux du Très-Saint-Sacrement* at Quebec, designated by the Superior-General or the Provincial, whenever there is a Provincial having the power to make such appointments."

3. Section 8 of the said act is replaced by the following:

"8. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, its property shall be liquidated in the manner provided by the laws then in force."

CHAP. 124

An Act to incorporate *Les Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*

[Assented to, the 15th of February, 1924]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Reverend Fathers Marie-Clement Staub, Tranquille Pesse, and Clodoald Sériex, all three *Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*, have, by their petition, represented:

That they have founded in the city of Quebec, with the approval of His Eminence Cardinal Bégin, Archbishop of Quebec, an establishment of their Order with the object of preparing missionaries for preaching and for their missions, and teachers for their work of education and instruction;

That for the attainment of their objects, they require to acquire and hold property, and therefore desire to be created a body corporate;

Whereas they have prayed for incorporation as a civil corporation, and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Incorporation.

1. The said Reverend Fathers Marie-Clément Staub, Tranquille Pesse and Clodoald Sériex, together with all persons who, in accordance with the constitution and by-laws of their Order, may become associated with them or succeed them, are hereby incorporated under the name of *Les Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*. Each and every one
