3. Section 8 of the said act is replaced by the following:

"8. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, its property shall be liquidated in the manner provided by the laws then in force."

CHAP. 124

An Act to incorporate *Les Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*

[Assented to, the 15th of February, 1924]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Reverend Fathers Marie-Clement Staub, Tranquille Pesse, and Clodoald Sériex, all three *Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*, have, by their petition, represented:

That they have founded in the city of Quebec, with the approval of His Eminence Cardinal Bégin, Archbishop of Quebec, an establishment of their Order with the object of preparing missionaries for preaching and for their missions, and teachers for their work of education and instruction;

That for the attainment of their objects, they require to acquire and hold property, and therefore desire to be created a body corporate;

Whereas they have prayed for incorporation as a civil corporation, and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Incorporation.

1. The said Reverend Fathers Marie-Clément Staub, Tranquille Pesse and Clodoald Sériex, together with all persons who, in accordance with the constitution and by-laws of their Order, may become associated with them or succeed them, are hereby incorporated under the name of *Les Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*. Each and every one

shall be a member of such corporation only insofar as he really belongs to the said *Congrégation des Pères Augustins de l'Assomption*.

2. The corporation shall have perpetual succession and may have a common seal which it may alter at will. Perpetual succession and seal.

3. The corporation may:

a. Appear before the courts in the same manner as any other person may do; Powers of corporation.

b. Accept, acquire and hold moveable and immoveable property under any legal title, provided the value of the immoveables does not exceed three hundred thousand dollars, according to the municipal valuation;

c. Lease, hypothecate, sell, exchange, convey or otherwise dispose of all its moveable and immoveable property under any legal title;

d. Make by-laws respecting its internal government and the administration and disposal of its property, and amend or repeal the same when necessary;

e. Appoint officers, procurators and administrators and determine their powers.

4. The signatures of the superior and of the procurator of the *Pères Augustins de l'Assomption* in this Province shall be binding upon the corporation in all its affairs. Corporation bound by signatures.

5. The corporate seat of the corporation shall be at Bergerville, Quebec, but may be changed at will by by-law regularly passed by the corporation, provided it be in the Province of Quebec. Such by-law, before coming into force, must be published for six months in the *Quebec Official Gazette* and in a French and an English newspaper in the locality to which such corporate seat is to be transferred, or, if there be no such newspapers, in newspapers of the nearest locality thereto. Corporate seat and change thereof.

6. The corporation shall transmit to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, annually in the month of January, and whenever thereunto required, a statement of the property held by the corporation, the names of its officers, and a copy of its rules and by-laws. Statement forwarded to Lt.-Gov. in C.

7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
