An Act respecting the school commissioners of the school municipality of the village of Notre-Dame-de-Granby

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1924]

WHEREAS the school commissioners of the school municipality of the village of Notre-Dame-de-Granby have, by their petition, represented that they hold, in payment of a debt to them owing by Joseph Léopold Dozois, a certain immoveable property situated in the city of Granby, in virtue of a deed of sale with a right of redemption from Miss Mildred Dozois, a daughter, of the age of majority, of the said Joseph Léopold Dozois, passed before Joseph Lemieux, notary public;

Whereas the said Miss Mildred Dozois held the said immoveable property by title from her mother Dame Sarah Elizabeth Savage, wife of the said Joseph Léopold Dozois; the said immoveable property having been to her conveyed by deed of donation passed before the same notary;

Whereas it is necessary to ratify such deeds, and to declare them valid for all legal purposes;

Whereas the petitioners have prayed for the passing of an act to the above effect; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The deed of donation passed between Dame Sarah Elizabeth Savage and Miss Mildred Dozois, on the 8th of January, 1924, at Granby, before Joseph Lemieux, notary public, under the No. 2607 of his minutes, and the deed of sale with right of redemption passed between Miss Mildred Dozois and the school commissioners of the school municipality of the village of Notre-Dame-de-Granby, at Granby, on the 8th of January, 1924, before Joseph Lemieux, notary public, under the No. 2608 of his minutes, are hereby ratified and confirmed and declared legal and valid for all legal purposes.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
