An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Charles Auguste Décary to the practice of medicine and surgery, after examination

[Assented to, the 15th of February, 1924]

WHEREAS Charles Auguste Décary, of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That in 1917 he was admitted as a student of medicine and surgery at Laval University in Montreal, and that he followed the medical course in the said university for the five years prescribed;

That in 1922 the Montreal University granted him a diploma as Doctor of Medicine;

That up to the present he has not been able to obtain from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec a license authorizing him to practise medicine, because he had never made application for admission to the study of medicine, and when he took the University examinations, he did not take the examination before the examiners of the said College;

That nevertheless, on the 6th of September, 1922, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec gave its consent to the presentation of a bill to authorize the petitioner to practise medicine after having passed before the board of examiners of the said College an oral examination in science, and the final examination required for the license;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed to the effect above mentioned; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Charles Auguste Décary among its members, and to grant him the license required for the practice of medicine in the Province, after examination.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
