

## C H A P. 6

An Act to amend the act respecting the enlargement of the Court House of the district of Quebec

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 1 of the act 12 George V, chapter 3, is <sup>12 Geo. V,</sup> amended: <sub>e. 3, s. 1, am.</sub>

*a.* By inserting therein, after the word: "land", in the sixth line thereof, the words: "and of the furnishings";

*b.* By replacing the word: "three", in the sixth line thereof, by the word: "five".

**2.** Section 3 of the said act is amended:

*a.* By inserting therein, after the word: "construction", <sup>12 Geo. V,</sup> in the sixth line thereof, the words: "and of the furnishings"; <sub>e. 3, s. 3, am.</sub>

*b.* By inserting therein, after the word: "construction", in the ninth line thereof, the words: "and of the furnishings";

*c.* By replacing the word: "three", in the tenth line thereof, by the word: "five".

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sub>force.</sub>

An Act to authorize the guarantee of a certain loan for the relief of the victims of the conflagration of the 1st of December, 1922, in the town of Terrebonne
